PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Somerville completed Phase II of the Regent Park Revitalization project. In June 2015, Phase III began and Somerville was contracted to undertake the construction of the site servicing including:

Municipal Infrastructure - Somerville was responsible for the removal of existing and subsequent replacement of pavement, curbs, sidewalks, boulevards, storm sewers, sanitary sewers and watermains along Wyatt, Tubman, Nicholas, Oak, Sackville, and Dreamer's Way.

Streetlighting: Somerville was responsible for the removal and replacement of new streetlighting infrastructure within the Phase III project area. This included 30+ lights, with applicable ductbank, handwells and interconnection to Toronto Hydro Standard.

District Energy Piping: Regent Park Energy Inc. is owned by Toronto Community Housing. RPEI designed and built a District Energy System that encompassed the whole of Regent Park. Somerville was responsible for the installation of the hot and chilled water piping.
